



## Revival: When the Holy Spirit Moves

Psalm 126:4-6

Often, believers and churches have vague or differing ideas and expectations of revival—many confessing that they may only recognize revival when they see it. Like many believers throughout history, we long to experience God’s movement among His people in a dramatic way. The Psalmist describes two avenues God may use to bring revival among His people. ***He may utilize the...***

### I. The F\_\_\_\_\_ of Revival (v. 4)

“For I will pour water on the thirsty land  
and streams on the dry ground;

I will pour out My Spirit on your descendants  
and My blessing on your offspring.

<sup>4</sup>They will sprout among the grass  
like poplars by flowing streams.”

Isaiah 44:3-4

### II. The F\_\_\_\_\_ of Revival (vv. 5-6)

“They will come and shout for joy on the heights of Zion;  
they will be radiant with joy

because of the LORD’s goodness,  
because of the grain, the new wine, the fresh oil,  
and because of the young of the flocks and herds.

Their life will be like an irrigated garden,  
and they will no longer grow weak from hunger.

<sup>13</sup>Then the young woman will rejoice with dancing,  
while young and old men rejoice together.

I will turn their mourning into joy,  
give them consolation,  
and bring happiness out of grief.”
