The Lord Roars

Amos 1:1-2:16

The roar of a lion warns the rest of the animal kingdom that their lives are in peril if they do not take steps to change their situations. Amos uses this analogy of the lion's roar to warn that *The Lord Roars against...*

I. F\_\_\_\_\_ (1:3-1:10)

I will require the life of every animal and every man for your life and your blood. I will require the life of each man's brother for a man's life. <sup>6</sup>Whoever sheds man's blood, his blood will be shed by man, for God made man in His image. <sup>7</sup>But you, be fruitful and multiply; spread out over the earth and multiply on it." Genesis 9:5-7

II. D\_\_\_\_\_ R\_\_\_\_\_ (1:11-2:3)

Say to the Ammonites: Hear the word of the Lord God: This is what the Lord God says: Because you said, 'Good!' about My sanctuary when it was desecrated, about the land of Israel when it was laid waste, and about the house of Judah when they went into exile... Ezekiel 25:3

III. C\_\_\_\_\_ R\_\_\_\_\_ (2:4-5)

There is no favoritism with God. Romans 2:11

IV. U\_\_\_\_\_ (2:6-16)

The rich and the poor have this in common:  
the LORD made them both.

<sup>22</sup>Don't rob a poor man because he is poor,  
and don't crush the oppressed at the gate,

<sup>23</sup>for the LORD will take up their case  
and will plunder those who plunder them.
