Interim Pastor Ministries provides temporary (interim) pastors to strengthen churches during pastoral transition for greater effectiveness with as little spiritual or emotional strain as possible. An Interim Pastor is a temporary shepherd who is trained to lead a church through specific steps toward a healthy beginning for the arrival of the new pastor.


