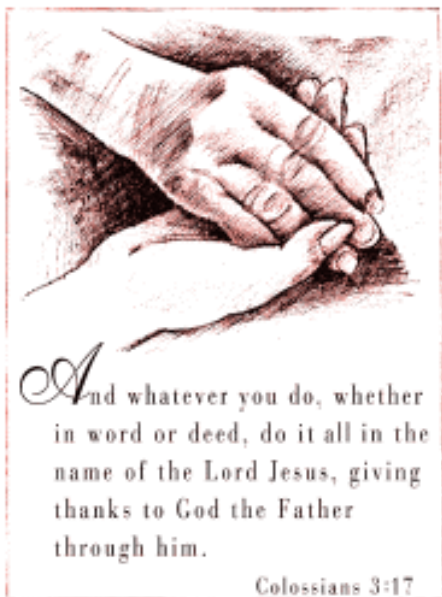

important role in our church.**

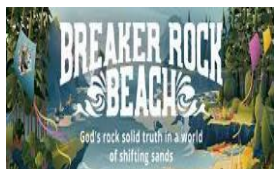
Announcement from the Church Office

Church Family,

COLOSSIANS 3:12-17

"Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you have a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.

Let the peace of Christ rule your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him."

In Paul's writing he gives us a strategy to help us live day by day. Imitating Christ's compassionate and forgiving attitude. Let love

guide your life and let the peace of Christ rule in your heart. Always be kind and thankful! Keep God's Word in your heart at all times and live as a representative of Jesus Christ.
