A Word from Bro. Mark -

Outside the church walls

It was my pleasure to participate in the dedication service of the Toledo Bend Resort Ministry's new ministry building last Sunday. I spent the hour before the service driving up and down the backroads of the area observing life being lived there. There are so many dwellings. Some are very elaborate and some very simple. Some are occasional vacation homes and others house more than one family every day.

Through TBRM, churches of our area have a "beachhead" on Toledo Bend Lake to reach vacationers, retirees, local residents and particularly the youngest citizens of Sabine Parish. FBC Many should take "pride" (the kind where something has honored the Lord) in the ministry it has supported for a long time.

Some things to propel us as a church on mission to reach folks in the area:

- 1. The community is dynamic meaning there are always new folks around visiting as well as permanent residents from a wide range of socioeconomic backgrounds. Every new face is an opportunity to share the Love of Jesus.
- 2. There are people around us all year round that have lost connection with a church and drifted far from the Lord. Just an invitation to church or VBS or lunch could be the catalyst to changing a life.
- 3. There are people around us that have never come to a saving knowledge of Christ. We should be passionate about reaching them.
- 4. We should support the folks that serve through TBRM through prayer, encouraging words, finances and time given.

This last month I've preached a lot about the Apostle Paul's ministry through missionary journeys. I can't dismiss the notion that ministry in Sabine parish is a lot like ministry in the province of Achaia mentioned in the book of Acts, chapters 17 and 18. That's where Athens and Corinth lies. One city is an intellectual crossroads and the other is a crossroads of culture and trade. Paul gave all he had of himself to tell those busy people about Jesus and it propagated the Church.

Let's live that way too. Let's get busy sharing Jesus at the crossroads.

Thank you Lord for the leadership that makes Toledo Bend Resort Ministry happen - Mary Gore, Danny Warmack, Ron Thompson and Jack Bell. Y'all are godly heroes on a missionary journey!
