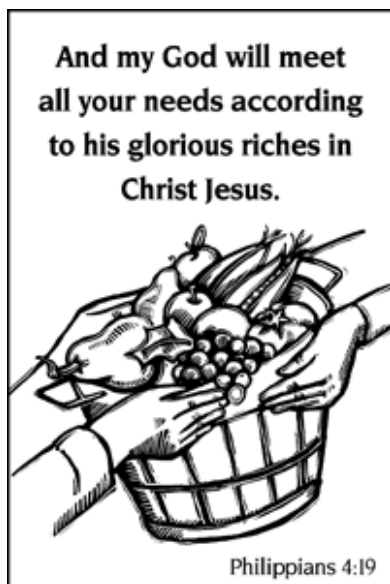

God Will Provide

*But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19*

We often come to God with requests for whatever we have determined are necessities in our lives. We look at the situations that arise, ascertain the outlook we desire, and petition God for the provision of our chosen outcome. However, is this process one of trust and dependence? Or is this the action of one whose desire outweighs their faith?

Faith is more than simply believing God will provide. Faith is an attitude of heart that recognizes God is the sole judge of right, just, and good. Faith rests in God's justice and mercy, accepting from His hand the course He chooses and the outcome He desires.
