Notes from the Pastor Search Committee:

Dear Church Family,

We are familiar with David's Psalm 34:3 that says, *"Oh, magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt his name together!"* This verse was the theme verse for our VBS this summer, and Bro Bo Owens quoted this same verse regularly.

If you take the time to read all 22 verses of Psalm 34, you will notice that God promises great blessings. God frees us from fears; he listens; he saves; he guards; he surrounds; he rescues! But many of these blessings require action on our part. We are to cry out to him in prayer; take refuge in him; fear him; turn from evil; seek peace; and serve him.
