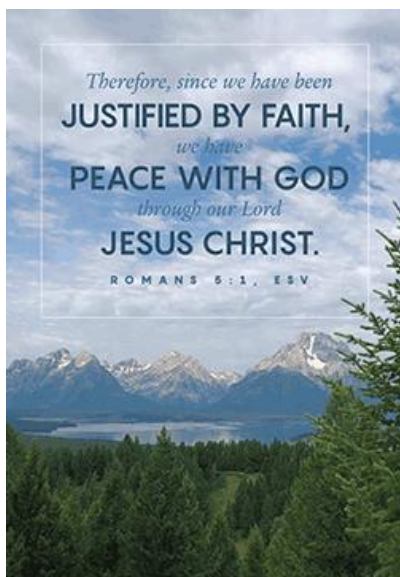

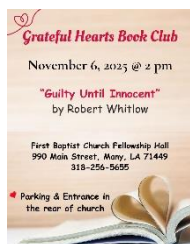
Bereavement Committee In Need of Volunteers

Notes from the Pastor Search Committee:

Dear Church Family,

Are you looking for peace? The Bible tells us peace is made possible through Christ Jesus. Peace is more than the absence of conflict.

Peace is more than a feeling. Peace is completeness and wholeness. Peace is the security realized by being in a restored relationship. It is not attained by our right living but by being “in Christ”.
